

## **Overview**

You will work with physicians, physician assistants and nurses to treat the sick and injured in all kinds of Canadian Forces (CF) operations and units.

## **Duties**

Treat the sick and injured in all kinds of military activity.

Provide initial care for sick and injured patients and basic life support to trauma patients, prescribe some medications, provide medical support on military training exercises or operations, recover casualties and transport them to a medical facility, give basic advice on disease prevention, hygiene and sanitation.

## **Requirements**

- Medical Technicians must have a High School Diploma with a grade 12 or Secondary V level Biology course and Science course (Chemistry or Physics), and hold a valid driver's license.
- Basic Military Qualification (BMQ) course.
- 4-week Soldier Qualification.

Medical Technicians are posted to a Canadian Forces health care unit in Canada. Followed the Maintenance of Clinical Skills Program (MCSP).

This occupation requires dedication, hard work, and the desire and ability to carry out tasks in difficult circumstances for extended period of time.
